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Proceedings of the Regular Meeting of the Mayor and Council were held on Monday, July 20, 2020 at Washington Town Hall, 405 N. Washington, St. Washington, La.

A motion was made by Mr. Beau Wilson to approve the minutes of the last meetings and seconded by Mr. Malveaux; all were in favor and motion passed.

Councilman Beau Wilson introduced Ordinance # 4 of 2020 and Ordinance to Sell Immovable property.

The mayor informed the council about renewing the town insurance with Dupre Carriere & Godcheaux, adjustments were made to the coverage and now all assets are at the proper level. This resulted an approximate 40 % in the town.

Mayor Landreneau spoke to council about selling the fire truck. He asked the council if anyone had found a grant to restore the fire truck. No one has been able to find funds to restore the truck.

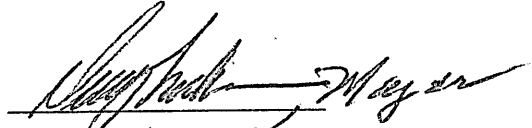

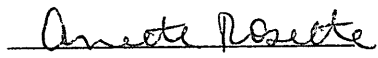
