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A Public hearing was held to discuss Ordinance #4, An Ordinance to sell immovable property and to consider levying or increasing millage rates without further voter approval or adopting the adjusted millage rate after reassessment and rolling forward to rates not to exceed the prior year's maximum. The public hearing to consider the millage rates was postponed to a later date due to the requirement that four of the council members were not physically present at the meeting in person.

Proceedings of the Regular Meeting of the Mayor and Council were held on Monday, August 17, 2020 at Washington Town Hall, 405 N. Washington, St. Washington, La.

Mr. Wilson discussed the minutes of the July meeting regarding the selling of the skate park equipment. The council did approve to sell the skate park equipment and not the property. The July minutes will be amended to reflect the change.

A motion was made by Mr. Beau Wilson to approve the minutes of the last meetings and seconded by Ms. Doucet. Council members Beau Wilson, Tanya Doucet, Wilbert Ledet voted to amend the minutes. Council member Mona Wilson abstained; motion passed.

The agenda item under Old Business-the adoption of Ordinance# 4 the Sale of Immovable Property on the corner of Washington and St. Mitchell Street. All council members approved the sale of the immovable surplus property.

Resolution #1 To adopt the Adjusted Millage rates and Resolution #2 to set fourth the Adjusted Millage rates and roll forward were tabled to a later date.

A motion was made by Ms. Doucet to adopt a resolution to appoint Mayor William Dwight Landreneau to serve as a Director and appoint Mr. Wilbert Ledet as the alternate Director to the LMGA Board of Directors and seconded Ms. Wilson. All were in favor and the resolution was adopted.

A motion was made by Ms. Doucet to reappoint Mr. Donald Robinson and Mr. Gregory Doucet to the Fire District II Board of Commission and seconded by Mr. Wilson. All were in favor and motion passed.

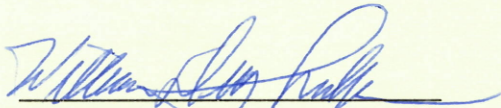
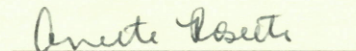
The Introduction to amend Ordinance #3-Authority to Set Utility Rates was tabled.
