## TOWN OF WASHINGTON REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

Monday July 19, 2021, 6:00 PM Washington Town Hall 405 N. Washington St. Washington, LA

Mayor William Dwight Landreneau called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Dwight Landreneau recognized a quorum established.

Councilmember Mona Wilson suggested having a meeting with the business owners to alert them of the concerning situation. Councilmember Beau Wilson suggested getting the Historic District Committee involved. Mayor Landreneau offered to meet with Donna to begin the process to implement the some of the suggestions.

Councilmember Beau Wilson presented for resident Richard Soileau a concern for a "DEAD END" sign on Pecan St. to recognize it is not a through street to avoid any accidents. Mayor Landreneau has discussed with DOTD and the Utility Supervisor to place a sign.

Chief Trent gave an update on Blue Line Solutions to the council explaining implementation and training will be taking place in the coming month. Chief Trent gave details on how the program works.

Mayor Landreneau explained he was approached regarding annexation to expand the city limits for the Town Washington. The last census the Town has 906 people. It is something being considered.
